We do professional development for teachers and Social Emotional Learning (SEL) staff. We provide Bus Tickets for our after-school programs. Golden Ciphers

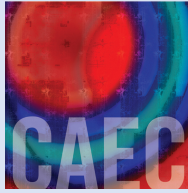

***In response to CAEC's SurveyMonkey questions:
92 surveys provided program statistics and
83 of the 92 surveys provided greater school details.***

62 of 83 (75%) surveys reported members being in CMSD and wanting to continue

12 of 83 (14%) surveys reported members not in CMSD and interested

9 of 83 (11%) surveys reported members not in CMSD
and not able or interested at the time of this survey

- **FROM SIX MULTIPLE CHOICE QUESTIONS**

- 66 provided live performances, presentations or demonstrations – 52 provided exhibitions and workshops

- 24 provided long residencies – 27 provided short residencies

- 73 provided some family and parent involvement depending on the time and program

- 79 presented programs in school classrooms, auditoriums, all-purpose rooms, gymnasiums

- 47 presented programs in their own facilities, shared or rented community spaces

- 44 provided training and professional development
