"News You Can Use" Program History 2008-2023 Cleveland Arts Education Consortium

Over the course of the CAEC residency at Cleveland State University, 2008 and 2023, our seasonal program schedule grew in focus, depth and number of events. Informal gatherings called "Coffee with Judy" were introduced. Expanded coffees each Friday were a lifeline and serious network builder for members throughout the entirety of the pandemic. As things are normalizing in 2023, CAEC events are gradually returning to in-person coupled with a variety of easy to attend online sessions.

Many 2008-2020 1-2 hour programs and daylong professional development workshops were held in CSU buildings from Mather Mansion and the Student Center to the Urban College and Administrative buildings — and in many different member facilities in Greater Cleveland from Coventry Peace Park on the eastside to Beck Center on the west, and everywhere in between.

We are extremely grateful that CAEC members were able to provide spaces and host CAEC sessions. As you scan this list you will see different sessions set in large and small locations, including one famously icy February 2019 special needs program in the beautiful Community Room in Cleveland Public Library.

As we establish new nonprofit status, begin to co-locate with Assembly for the Arts and move away from the CSU residency July 2023, the general thrust of CAEC programs will continue. With these activities and more, we will share information around important issues, interests and concerns.

CAEC's overall purpose continues with CAEC as a hub of an expansive and growing network, there to listen and to offer ideas and new resources to help members and other participants as they develop a wide range of engaged arts learning activities for people in every corner of Northeast Ohio and far beyond.
